St Peter's Church has served the Limpsfield community, locally and beyond, and been part of its heritage for centuries. The first record of a church in Limpsfield is in the Domesday Book in 1086, with the oldest part of the present church (the south aisle and tower) thought to have been built around 1180. Today, St Peter's and its churchyard remain at the heart of the village, offering a space for many different needs, both religious and secular.
